**The following questions are merely ways to help remember your deceased loved one. Also, these questions and answers are helpful to the Priest/Deacon as he prepares for the Funeral Service. Your answers can be brief and please answered on a separate sheet of paper.**

1. What were this person's favorite things to do? What kind of talents/skills/abilities did this person have? What was he/she good at? What did he/she enjoy doing? For example, recreation, hobbies, sports, music, music, indoor/outdoor activities, cooking, shopping, etc. Any favorite foods?
2. What did you like most about this person? What will you miss most about this person?
3. What did this person achieve/accomplish that you admire?
4. What were this person's favorite expressions, sayings...things he/she said often?
5. How would you describe this person to another? Kind, caring, witty, funny, determined, quiet, creative, etc.?
6. What made him/her happy? What brought joy to his/her life?
7. What kinds of values did this person have?
8. What kind of good did this person do, that may be unknown to others?
9. By what name was he/she most commonly called? Describe briefly history of health, eventual cause of death.
10. Describe this person's faith life and involvement in the Church.

11. List the names of the surviving relatives.

12. List the names of the relatives who preceded in death.

13. Is there anything special after Mass.?
